- Swearing In Ceremony and Appointment to Committees
 - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HOUSING/GENERAL GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE
 - Addresses community development and housing needs or concerns, including neighborhood and community preservation, community development plans, housing code enforcement, zoning, etc.
 - PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
 - Addresses transportation, including public transit; infrastructure, including road development or closures; public art; etc.

January

- Meet with City Departments and Community Stakeholders
- Learn about and begin budget development process

February

- Community Engagement
 - Neighborhood and Town Hall Meetings
 - Develop process for community advocates/ambassadors/board
 - Begin marketing campaign for programs and services to help community
 - Weatherization Program (Piedmont Triad Regional Council)
 - Transforming Urban Residential Neighborhoods (TURN)

March

- Establish reporting mechanism to relay information regarding concerns back to community
- Identify initial community advocates/ambassadors/board
- Identify recipients for Weatherization program and TURN
